SCORING: Modified Double Elimination (4 or more in a division) Round Robin (3 or less in a division)

MATCH TIMES: Senior and Master's Division, 4 min. Junior: 3 min

RULES: The current rules of the International Judo Federation (IJF) as modified.

1. GOLDEN SCORE will apply to ALL DIVISIONS.
2. NO Kansetsu waza allowed in Junior Division
3. Shime waza allowed for 13 yrs. of age and older.
4. Kansetsu waza allowed in all senior divisions regardless of contestants' age. (Minimum age to enter senior division is 13 years)

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, in any Judo tournament, practice, clinic, and related events and activities of the **United States Judo Federation, Inc., United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Association, Inc., Konan Judo Association, Hackett Catholic Central High School, Kalamazoo City School District, and the Southside Dojo Inc,** I hereby:

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. Agree that, prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due not only to my own actions, inactions or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
